



HOW TO PROPOSE A TOPIC FOR *topiCS*

The easiest way is to send an e-mail note directly to the Executive Editor, Wayne Gray, at grayw@rpi.edu. Keep this first note short (about 400-800 words or fewer). Be sure to indicate the topic category that you think it fits (Increasing Range and Scope, Integration and Reflection, or Great Debates). Say something about why this is a topic for a cognitive science journal rather than a specialty journal. Also say something about the cognitive science perspectives that you envision contributing to the topic (e.g., behavioral, neuroscience, computational, linguistic, robotic, anthropological, educational, and/or philosophical). If your topic is based on a successful symposium, workshop, or a new grouping of researchers, then say something about this as well.
